 - 2: Qe4+ and mate soon
 - 3: Re7 (forces Rook exchange and easy King/Rook ending)
 - 4: Bf6
- Page 3:**
- 1: RxN(6)
 - 2: Bf8 and then Bd5
 - 3: Rg8+ , King moves. check King AGAIN with other rook, capture Queen
 - 4: g4 Bg6 f5
- Page 4:**
- 1: Qe6+ Kh8 Nf7+ Kh8 Nh6++ Kh8 Qg8+ RxQ Nf7 # (amazing !!)
